Parish Council News

The Parish Council continue to follow up issues and concerns about village maintenance and safety. They are currently negotiating with other authorities about repairing the area near Potter Heigham Bridge, the possibility of installing more waste/dog bins, looking into how young people can more safely catch the bus to school, looking into how flooding in Tower Road and other areas can be better prevented, and keeping the grass verges and other open spaces cut or cleared.

The external audit and Annual Return for the council has been completed and published on the Village Hall notice board and on the website. Allotment fees are now due and tenants should have received letters inviting them to renew during October.

The plaque was fixed to the Jubilee seat in October by Borough Councillors Mary and Barry Coleman.

As members of the public, you are welcome to parish council meetings. The next meeting following this newsletter will be on 8th December at 8pm in the Village Hall.
