Repps with Bastwick Parish Council manages allotment gardens situated to the right of the access track leading from Church Road, and prior to the 's' bend.

Plots are let to residents of Repps with Bastwick. Tenants enter into an Agreement with the Parish Council and are invoiced by the parish council during October.

Parish Council News

The Parish Council continue to report issues with highways, flooding, hedges, grass cutting, potholes, street lighting and more, to the relevant authorities to be dealt with. <http://reppscumbastwickpc.norfolkparishes.gov.uk/report-it/> The Council met with Anglian Water to discuss the new sewerage scheme, which was followed by a public drop-in consultation with Anglian Water in July. GYBC Building Control have advised: once a resident has decided to connect to the new Anglian Water sewer they will need to employ someone to carry out the works (make the connection) and arrange to have these works inspected by Building Control at Great Yarmouth Borough Council. An application form can be downloaded from the Parish Council website, or by contacting building Control at GYBC.

Speeding in the village is a continuing problem and the council have been looking at options to help control traffic speeds. Councillors from Rollesby and Martham parish councils came to speak to the Council about their ideas for a Neighbourhood Plan, which would enable parishioners to have more of a say about how their villages develop in line with the GYBC Local Plan. The parish councillors continue to offer their comments about planning applications, but it is the Borough Council or Broads Authority who make the decision to approve or object to a planning application. Parish Council meetings have temporarily moved venue while the Village Hall is undergoing building work. Please see the website and the Mercury Village Life section for September 6th's meeting. There is no meeting in August. Members of the public are welcome and have an opportunity to put their questions, concerns and views to the council.
